December 17, 1925 - June 10, 2017

Marguerite Annen Tate, 91 of Danville, VA died Saturday, June 10, 2017 at Danville Regional Medical Center after a decline in health for the past two years.

Mrs. Tate was born in Paris, France on December 17, 1925 a daughter of the late Jock and Louise Annen.

She was in the Red Cross in Paris France during WWII. She worked for Dan River Mills for a number of years and later was the manager of the Downtowner Motor Inn. She was a member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church and attended The Church of the Second Coming.

She was married to, Ernest Blair Tate, who died on January 21, 1992.

Survivors include two daughters, Mary T. Karnes (Terry), Toni T. Barker; four grandchildren, one granddaughter -in-law, seven great grandchildren, and four great-great-grandchildren.
