Mary Ellen Powell Bray, 92, formally of Danville, VA went home to be with her Lord on Saturday, September 26, 2020 at Transitions Hospice Home in Raleigh, NC after being in declining health for several months.

Mrs. Bray was born on December 2, 1927, in Pittsylvania County, VA, daughter of the late John Willie Powell and Janie Elizabeth Myers Stowe Powell. She grew up in the Danville area until she moved to Charlotte, NC in 1965. She worked as an accounts payable supervisor at J. B. Ivey's /Dillard's in Charlotte, NC for over thirty years. After her retirement they moved back to Danville in 1999 until her health failed.

She was a faithful member of Third Ave Congregational Christian Church where she was a member of the Chapel Bible Class, the Circle Group, and Young at Hearts Seniors. She enjoyed attending church as much as possible, spending time with her family and shopping. She also enjoyed doing crossword puzzles, word finds and jigsaw puzzles in her spare time.

On August 9, 1947 Mrs. Bray married the late Calvin "Adie" Andrew Bray who died on September 16, 2007.
