



Rev. William C. Blalock

September 3, 1936 - January 12, 2018

Rev. William Chalmers Blalock, 81, of 173 Martindale Dr., Danville, VA died on Friday, January 12, 2018 at Roman Eagle Rehabilitation and Health Care Center after being in declining health for the past few years.

Rev. Blalock was born in Union Level, VA on September 3, 1936, a son of the late Paul Monroe Blalock and the late Nannie Gordon Blalock. He attended Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary where he received his Master Degree in Theology. After finishing college, he served numerous churches in North Carolina and South Carolina before moving back to Virginia. Most recently he served as Pastor at Woodlawn Baptist Church in Danville and later at Sandy Creek Baptist Church in Ringgold.

Rev. Blalock is survived by his wife of 59 years, Joyce White Blalock; two daughters, Joy Holt and husband Wayne, of Eden, NC, and Hope Adams, of Danville; three grandchildren, Tabitha Holt, Michelle Darling, and Kieth Darling; one great grandchild, Alina Posey; and several nieces and nephews.

In addition to his parents, he was predeceased by two brothers and three sisters.

A Memorial Service will be conducted on Friday, January 19, 2018 at 2:00 PM at Woodlawn Baptist Church with the Reverend David Turbyfill officiating. The family will receive friends one hour prior to the service and at other times will be at the residence.
