



Aldine Shelton Woicikowski

April 11, 1935 - June 3, 2023

Aldine Shelton Woicikowski, 88, of 158 Dotmond Road, Milton, NC went home to be with her Lord on Saturday, June 3, 2023 at Duke Hospital in Durham, NC.

Aldine was born in Ringgold, VA on April 11, 1935, a daughter of the late Howard Taft Shelton and Estelle Gibson Shelton. As a teenager she worked at S.S. Kresge Co. Store in Danville, VA until she graduated from Bartlett Yancey High School in 1954. After graduation she went on to work as a secretary for Clarke Printing.

On June 26, 1954, Aldine married Philip Walter Woicikowski. Together they owned and operated Skitco Tile Company and later owned and operated P & A Tile Company until her husband passed away.

After his death, Aldine worked as a bookkeeper for her son Walter's business for over thirteen years.

Aldine was a faithful member of Milton Baptist Church. She was baptized at the age of fourteen in Country Line Creek. She was very active in her church, where she held many titles including, clerk from 1965 to 2023, treasurer from 1994 to 2023, trustee, and chairman of various committees.

Aldine was dedicated to her church, but her family held a special place in her heart. She loved spending time with them and she also loved to work in her

yard.

In addition to her parents and husband she was predeceased by a brother, Rev. James Clyde Shelton.

Survivors include her sons, Keith Philip Woicikowski and Walter Howard Woicikowski and his wife, Christal; her grandchildren Tiffany, Bradley (Ashley), and Christian (Courtney) Woicikowski; her great grandchildren, Zach, Stella May, Daxton, and Lucas Woicikowski; and her sister, Rachel Shelton Williams.

A graveside service will be conducted on Thursday, June 8, 2023 at 2:00 P.M. at Floral Hills Memory Gardens, in Danville, VA, with the Reverend Robert Hicks officiating.
