



Alfred Leon Law

November 12, 1944 - January 23, 2024

Alfred Leon Law, age 79 of Danville, Virginia passed away peacefully at SOVAH Health on Tuesday, January 23, 2024, after months of declining health. Leon was born on November 12, 1944, in Newton Missouri, to the late Alfred Andrew Law and Pearl Izetta Cabe Law.

Leon served in the US Army in the 101st Airborne Infantry as a Parachutist and Sharpshooter. He began his career at Goodyear Tire and Rubber Company in 1966 and retired after thirty-two years of service. Leon owned and operated Alfred L. Law General Contracting for many years and is known as 'Jack of all trades – Master of all' within the community, always willing to help others. Leon was a member of Poquoson Tribe Number 124 of the Improved Order of Red Men. In addition, Leon was an active member of Central Boulevard Church of God in Danville, Virginia.

In addition to his parents, he is predeceased by his brothers Allan Law and Larry Law.
