



Alfred Wayne "Dub" Nance

Alfred Wayne "Dub" Nance, 92, of Ringgold, VA, went home to be with his Lord and Savior on Tuesday, November 28, 2017 at SOVAH-Danville after a decline in health for the past few months.

Mr. Nance was born in Danville, VA on September 1, 1925, a son of the late Archie Addison Nance, Sr. and the late Ila Davis Nance. He spent most of his life in the Danville area where he retired as Vice President of Dibrell Brothers Tobacco Company. He was a longtime member of Grace Design United Methodist Church where he served as Church Treasurer.
