Alice Elizabeth Lee Hasson, 76, of Danville, died peacefully while surrounded by her family on Thursday, October 12, 2023.

Born on April 12, 1947, she was a daughter of the late Lloyd B. Lee and Alice M Oberlin of Bluefield, Virginia.

Alice was a 1966 Graduate of Graham High School and during high school taught dance to younger children. She spent time after graduation working with a Russian Ballet instructor in New York before returning to Bluefield and going to nursing school. neighborhood family and loved shopping and filling welcome baskets for their arrival.
