Alma Frances Dalton, 100, of Ringgold, VA went home to be with Lord on Sunday, June 8, 2025 after being in declining health for the past several months.

Frances was born in Pittsylvania County on June 5, 1925, a daughter to the late James Boisseau Williams and Lillie Frances Poindexter Williams. She grew up in the Mountain Hill Community where she worked on the family tobacco farm.

On July 29, 1944, she married Harry Ray Dalton. Frances then became a homemaker and still worked on their tobacco farm in the Kentuck community until they both retired. Harry Ray Dalton died on November 3, 2017. She was a member of Wesley Chapel United Methodist Church.

Frances is survived by a number of nieces and nephews.
