Ann H. Parrish, 95, of Danville, died on Saturday, December 13, 2025 at Commonwealth Senior Living at Stratford House.

Ann was born in Chatham on May 17, 1930, to the late Radah Pruitt Hodges Chism.

She was predeceased by her step-father, Ernest Chism.

Ann was also predeceased by her husband, W. Kermit Parrish, who died on May 27, 2014; and their daughter, Pamela Kaye Parrish, who died on July 20, 2022.

She is survived by a daughter, Brenda P. McGee of New Bern, NC; a sister, Liz Lewis of Chatham; a sister-in-law, Betty Stump of Ringgold; and a number of nieces and nephews.

Ann was an active, charter member of Unity Presbyterian Church.
