Ann Perkins Scruggs, 74, of 5857 Old NC HWY 86 N, Providence, NC, went home to be with the Lord on Wednesday, December 30, 2020, at her residence after a decline in health for the past five years.

Ann was born in Danville, VA, on December 30, 1946, a daughter of the late Charles Henry Perkins and the late Elizabeth Ann Bailey Perkins. She lived most of her life in the Providence Community of Caswell County. Ann was a graduate of Bartlett Yancey High School Class of 1965.
