



Anne "Amy" Atkins

Anne Marie "Amy" Haley Atkins was called to return to our Lord on Saturday, February 28, 2015, in Danville, Virginia. She was 71 years old. She was born on July 19, 1943 in Danville, VA, and she is the daughter of William Frederick Haley, Sr. and Rosemary Hellman Haley. Amy was a graduate of George Washington High School and Longwood College. She worked for many years as an elementary school teacher and a travel agent in South Boston, VA. After returning to Danville, she worked for National Business College, first as an Admissions Counselor and then as Director of Operations of the Danville Campus. Amy was a member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church and was active in Cursillo.

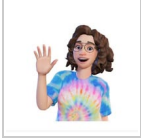
