Lillian Annette Law, 78 of 242 Serendipity Lane, Ruffin, NC, went to be with her Lord on October 11, 2017 at Roanoke Memorial Hospital in Roanoke, Va.

Ms. Law was born in Pittsylvania County on June 26, 1939, a daughter of the late Marion Francis Law and the late Mildred Comer Law. She spent most of her life in the Gatewood community in Caswell County.

Ms. Law was employed by Caswell County Schools as a Teacher's Assistant prior to her retirement. She was a member of Bethesda Presbyterian Church however she attended Bethel United Methodist Church where she was very active. Ms. Law coordinated the collection of canned goods and supplies in her church to be donated to Caswell Parish. She also managed the floral remembrances for her church. Among her many volunteer activities, Ms. Law served on the Caswell Parish Board and was also active with the Caswell County Animal Shelter.

Ms. Law is survived by one son, Carl Brent McGee and wife Renee of Fuquay-Varina, NC, one daughter, Shana M. Brandon and husband Eddie of Hurdle Mills, NC, three grandchildren, Blake Anthony Ward, Elizabeth Liles McGee, Margaret Law McGee and one sister Mary Caroline Law of Ruffin, NC.

A Memorial Service for Ms. Law will be conducted on Saturday, October 14, 2017 at 4:00 pm at Bethel United Methodist Church, 6258 Park Springs Road, Pelham, NC by the Reverend Jason Gaskins. The family will receive friends following the service at the church. Interment will follow at a late date.
