Annie Burnett Green, 88, of 3036 Sugar Tree Church Rd., Danville, VA, died on, November 30, 2018, at her residence after a decline in health for the past six months.

Mrs. Green was born in Galax, VA, on March 8, 1930, a daughter of the late Thomas Henry Burnett and the late Cora Fields Burnett.
