



Atron Thomas Calloway

August 16, 1928 - January 25, 2026

Atron Thomas Calloway, 97, of Danville went home to be with his Lord on Sunday, January 25, 2026 at Roman Eagle Rehabilitation and Healthcare Center.

Atron was born on August 16, 1928, a son of the late Young George Washington Calloway and Elosie Frances Elliott Calloway.

He served in the United States Army during the Korean War. Atron was married to Sallie Belle Towler Calloway who preceded him in death. He was employed by Dan River Mills where he worked in the card room and later retired from Hickson-DanChem. He was a member of First Pentecostal Holiness Church.

Atron was awarded the Roman Eagle Rehabilitation and Health Care Center Volunteer of the year in 2012. Additionally, Atron was awarded the Virginia Association of Activity Professionals Volunteer of the Year in 2014 (a volunteer State of Virginia Award).

Atron is survived by his children, Thomas Calloway (Belinda), George Calloway (Debra Yeaman), Brenda Calloway Walker (L.C.) and Michael Calloway (Terri); seven grandchildren; six great-grandchildren; three step great grandchildren; and numerous nieces and nephews.

In addition to his parents and wife, Atron is preceded in death by his brother, George Murial Calloway and sisters, Evon Francis Calloway Gosney and Nettie Faye Calloway Bailey.

The funeral service will be held on Thursday, February 5, 2026 at 1:00 p.m. at Wrenn-Yeatts Funeral Home, Westover Chapel with the Reverend Myron Bruce, the Reverend Mike Hearp and Mr. L.C. Walker officiating. Interment will follow in Danville Memorial Gardens.

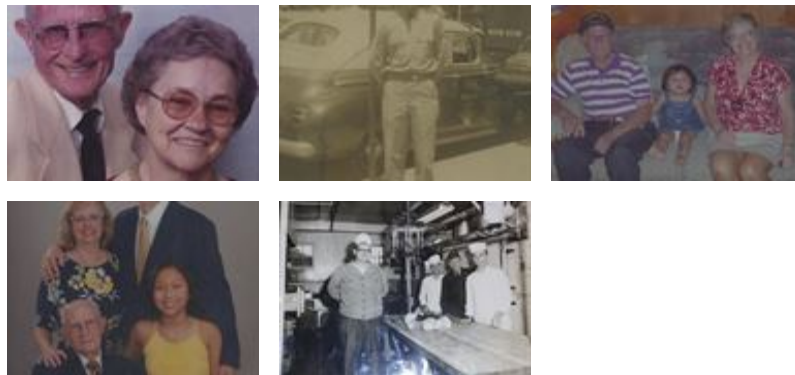

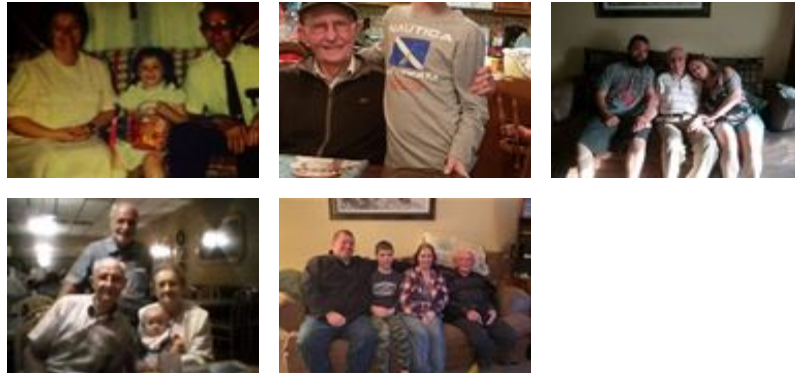
