



Avery Lee Marshall

April 20, 1942 - March 3, 2025

Avery Lee Marshall, 82, of Providence, NC, husband of Clara Poindexter Marshall, went home to be with his Lord and Savior on Monday, March 3, 2025 at his residence.

Born in Danville, VA on April 20, 1942, he was a son of the late Alvin Oscar Marshall and Nannie Irene Mabry Marshall. He was predeceased by his stepmother, Arstine Marshall.

On July 28, 1963, he married the love of his life, Clara M. Poindexter.

He was a graduate of Cobb Memorial High School, class of 1960. Avery accepted God's call into ministry in May of 1976. He received many degrees throughout his years and earned his Doctor of Divinity from Cambridge Theological Seminary in 2011. Through the years, he pastored several churches in the area. After stepping down from the pulpit, he attended True Gospel Baptist Church in Pelham, NC.

Avery was employed as a mechanic for Goodyear. He retired from Goodyear having been employed for over 30 years.

In addition to his wife of over 61 years, Clara, Avery is survived by his three children, Tonya Pleasant (Fred), Cynthia McNeill (Scott) and Steven Marshall

(Natalie); five grandchildren, Emily Yarbrough (Garrett), Haleigh Rice (Jason), Hannah McNeill, Gavin Pleasant and Braden Marshall; a sister, Vickie Lee (Danny); a brother-in-law, Robert Hearp and a brother, Jason Marshall.

Along with his parents and stepmother, Avery was preceded in death by his sister, Judy Hearp.

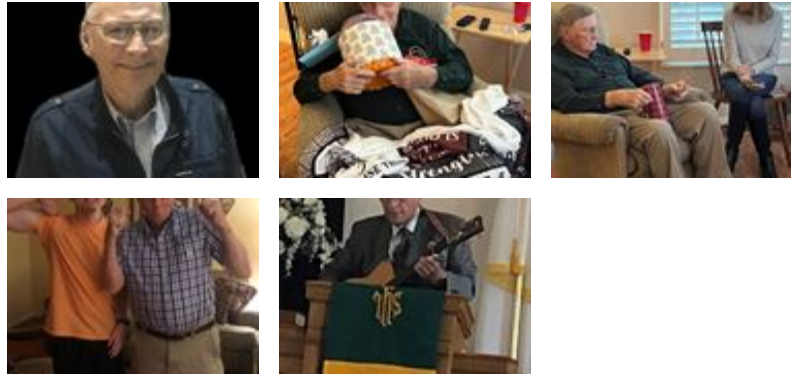
