Barbara Jean Berdine, 84, of 3842 N.C. Hwy 119 North, Leasburg, NC went home suddenly to be with the Lord on March 20, 2022 at her residence.

Barbara was born in Rushville, Indiana on December 2, 1938 a daughter of the late John Neuman and Irene Ruth Osborne Neuman. She lived most of her life in Fulton, Indiana prior to moving to the Leasburg, NC community in 2011.

She was a graduate of Rushville High School, Class of 1956. She was also a graduate of Indiana State College, Class of 1961. While living in Indiana she was a member of the Order of the Eastern Star.
