Barbara Ann Smith Mackey, 82, of 205 Kent Lane, Danville, Virginia went home to be with her Lord and Savior on September 9, 2018 at Stratford Rehabilitation Center after being in declining health for the past year.

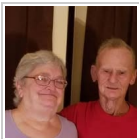
