



Benjamin "Dominecker" Vernon

March 7, 1926 - May 3, 2013

Benjamin Thomas "Dominecker" Vernon, 87 of 2620 Green Farm Road, Danville VA died on Friday, May 3, 2013 at Danville Regional Medical Center after being in declining health for the past year.

Mr. Vernon was born in Whitt, VA on March 7, 1926 a son of the late Hughe Thomas Vernon and the late Downey Warren Vernon. He spent all of his life in the Pittsylvania County area where he worked at Dan River Mills as a Loom Fixer. He was a WWII veteran, serving in the US Army. He was a member of Kentuck Baptist Church and was a life member of the Pittsylvania Hunting Club. He enjoyed hunting and fishing.

On April 24, 1948 he married Evelyn West Vernon, who survives of the residence.

In addition to his wife, Mr. Vernon is survived by three sons, Michael Thomas Vernon of Halifax, VA, Kenneth Ray Vernon and wife Joyce of Danville, VA, and Gary Wayne Vernon and wife Joanne of TX; one brother, Carter Bailey Vernon of Hampton, VA; eight grandchildren and seven great grandchildren.

In addition to his parents he was predeceased by three brothers and one sister.

A graveside service will be conducted on Wednesday, May 8, 2013 at 2:00 p.m. at the Vernon Family Cemetery with Evangelist Mike Newcomb officiating. Interment will follow in the family cemetery.
