December 12, 1918 - August 8, 2009

Berry Lee Doolin, Sr., 90, of 2812 Dodson Drive died Saturday, August 8, 2009 at the Kindred Hospital in Greensboro, NC. He had been in declining health since December and a patient in the hospital for two weeks.
