



Bettie Stevens Bennett

December 22, 1929 - February 25, 2024

Bettie Stevens Bennett, age 94, of Keeling, died on Sunday, February 25, 2024, after a brief decline in health.

Born December 22, 1929, in Danville, she grew up in Halifax County on “Spencer Hill” and was the only child of the late Roy Franklin Stevens and Sadie Dodson Stevens. She was predeceased by her husband of 55 years, Samuel Gideon Bennett, who passed away on December 22, 2009.

Mrs. Bennett was a longtime active member of Kentuck Baptist Church, where she taught the two-year-old Sunday School class, served in Vacation Bible School and was a member of the WMU.

A graduate of The Danville Memorial Hospital School of Nursing, she held many nursing positions at Memorial Hospital, completing her nursing career as a school nurse for Pittsylvania County Schools, all while assisting her husband on the farm. In her spare time, she enjoyed sewing and gardening and was an avid reader who enjoyed monthly visits to the Pittsylvania County Bookmobile.

She is survived by her daughters, Sarah B. Collins and husband, Keith, and Leigh Ann B. Shields and husband, Bobby, all of Keeling; two granddaughters, Lori B. Edwards and husband Jeremy of Tobaccoville, North Carolina, and

Hannah S. Contreras and husband, James of Washington D.C.; a great-grandson, Logan Edwards and great-granddaughter, Everleigh Contreras. Several nephews and a niece also survive her.

Funeral services will be held on Wednesday, February 28, 2024, at 11:00 A.M. at Kentuck Baptist Church with the Reverend Tim Lee officiating. Interment will follow in Highland Burial Park.

The family will receive friends one hour before the service at the church and other times at the residence of her daughter and son-in-law, Leigh Ann and Bobby Shields, 860 Bennett Circle in Keeling.
