



Betty Jo Brumfield

February 10, 1942 - September 7, 2025

Betty Jo Johnson Brumfield, 83, of Danville, VA, died Sunday, September 7, 2025 at Roman Eagle Rehabilitation and Health Care after a one month decline in her health.

Betty Jo was born in Farmville, VA, on February 10, 1942, a daughter of the late Leo Preston Johnson and LaMere McCall Johnson Pollard. She lived most of her life in Danville, VA, and she retired from the Danville Urologic Clinic where she worked as a Nurse and as Supervisor of the Nursing Team. Betty Jo previously worked at Danville Memorial Hospital.

Betty Jo was of the Christian faith. She was a graduate of Bluestone High School in Skipwith, VA, and the Danville Memorial Hospital School of Nursing. She enjoyed gardening and caring for and feeding her neighbors.

On April 10, 1964 she married Rafael Wayne Brumfield, who died on May 23, 2022.

Survivors include a son, Dr. Jay Christopher Brumfield (Sharon Levy) of Westfield, NJ; a daughter, Dr. Heather LaMere Greenfield (Adam) of Oldsmar, FL; a granddaughter, Lauren Brumfield of Cambridge, MA; a sister, Elaine Keane (Timothy); a half-brother, Gary Johnson (Ginger); and a half-sister, Martha Pollard.
