Betty Kronjak Rutledge, 88, formerly of Forestroad Drive, Danville, died on Saturday, March 24, 2012 at Stratford Rehab Center. Mrs. Rutledge was born in Bitner, Pennsylvania, on July 6, 1923 a daughter of the late Mike Kronjak and the late Sophia Kilpa Kronjak. She was a graduate of the first LPN Class of the former Memorial Hospital School of Nursing. She was a 1949 graduate of the former DTI Beauty School. She served in the United States Army in the medical corp. She was a member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church. On June 20, 1944 she married Dewey Maynard Rutledge, Sr. in Taunton, MA who predeceased her in 1987. Survivors include one son, Dewey M.
