



Beverly Reaves

October 3, 1918 - March 23, 2009

Mr. Beverly Wade Reaves, 90, formerly of Kentuck Rd. died on the morning of Monday, March 23, 2009 at Riverside Health Care Center. He was born on October 3, 1918 a son of the late Archie Cooper Reaves and the late Martha Chaney Reaves. Mr. Reaves lived most of his life in the Danville area where he worked as a meat cutter for the former Big Star Grocery Store and was a member of Moffett Memorial Baptist Church for nearly fifty years and was also a member of the Chapel Bible Class. Mr. Reaves served his country as a member of the United States Army during World War II and was a member of the American Legion Memorial Post 325 and the Danville Chapter of the Disabled American Veterans. In addition to his parents, Mr. Reaves was predeceased by his wife, Lorraine Pruette Reaves; two brothers, Samuel H. Reaves and Archie C. Reaves; and three sisters, Annie Lucille Reaves Yeatts, Ruth Reaves Ellison, and Delphia Reaves Bullock. He was the last survivor of his generation. He is survived by a number of nieces and nephews and special friends. Funeral services will be held 11:00 A.M. Thursday, March 26, 2009 from the graveside with the Reverend Jeffery Wright officiating. Interment will be in Highland Burial Park. American Legion Dan River Post 1097 will provide Military Honors. The family will receive friends the evening of Wednesday March 25, 2009 from 7:00-8:30 P.M. at Wrenn-Yeatts North Main Chapel.
