Bill Gunn "Red" Chisholm, 80, of 2449 Moorefield Bridge Road, died Saturday, August 29, 2009 at his home. He had been in declining health for the past two years. Mr. Chisholm was born in Halifax County, VA on October 30, 1928, a son of the late William Chisholm and the late Mattie Cliborne Chisholm. He had lived his life in Halifax Co., Lynchburg, VA, Amherst Co., and after his retirement he lived in Oxford, NC before moving to Danville in 1993. He retired from Owens-Illinois in Big Island, VA where he had worked in the Maintenance Dept. as a Mechanic and he taught welding at E.C. Glass High School in Lynchburg.
