King Solomon Murphy, Jr., 84, of Charles Towne Drive Danville died Thursday, December 11, 2014 at his residence after a decline in health for the past year.

Born on March 10, 1930 he was a son of the late King Solomon Murphy and Sadie Hudgins Murphy

Mr. Murphy was a Korean War Veteran serving in the Army. He worked at the Faith Home where he was President. He also helped his first wife run The Candle Shop in Blairs. He was a member of Chestnut Level Baptist Church.

He was first married to Marie Janney Murphy, who died on October 9, 2001, and then on March 23, 2013, he married, Sandy Amos Murphy, who survives.

In addition to his wife of the residence survivors include three step-daughters, Janice Carter, and husband, Charles; Cathi Amos; Kim A. 
