

## Billy Coleman Jones

November 1, 1947 - June 26, 2022

Billy Coleman Jones, 74, of 7315 Dry Fork Rd., went home to be with his Lord on June 26, 2022 at Lynchburg General Hospital after being in declining health for the past five years.

Billy was born in Danville, VA on November 1, 1947, a son of the late Rev. W.B. Jones and Anna Oakes Jones. HE spent all of his life in the Pittsylvania County area, where he graduated from Gretna High School in 1968. He then went on to serve his country in the United States Army from 1968 to 1970.

Billy was a constant and loving husband of 53 years to Louise West Jones. He will forever remain as a cherished part of her heart. He was also a beloved dad to his daughter, Angel Huff (Steven) of Kent Shore, VA.

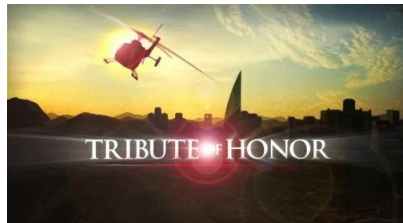

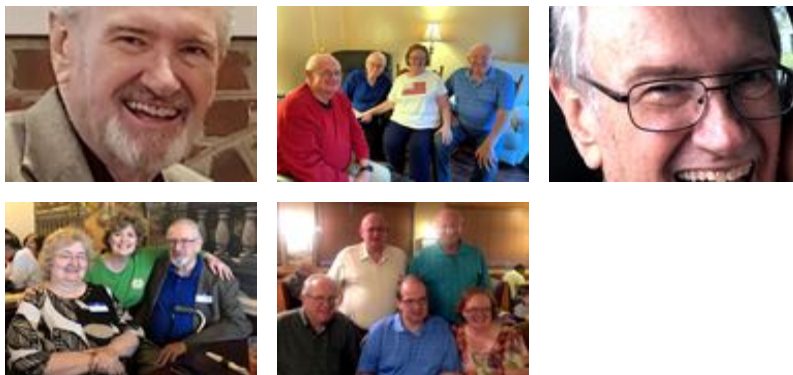
