



## Billy Gray Vaughan

December 23, 1943 - June 24, 2015

Billy Gray Vaughan, 71, of 1256 Hunting Hills Road, died, Wednesday, June 24, 2015 at Danville Regional Medical Center after a decline in health for the past three years.

Billy was born in Mecklenburg County, VA on December 23, 1943 a son of the late Johnnie Gray Vaughan and Molly Walker Vaughan.

Billy was the owner operator of Vaughan Mechanical Inc. which he started with his wife in 1981. He was of the Christian faith and enjoyed classic cars and cruise-ins.

On March 1, 1969 he married Nancy Porter Vaughan, who died on January 16, 2012.

Survivors include two daughters, Kathy Grant, and husband, Jeff, of Concord, VA; Tracy V. Gunnell, and friend, Keith Mustain; a son, Johnny Gray Vaughan, and wife, Robin, both of Danville; three grandchildren, Spencer Doss, Madison Gunnell, Trevor Grant and a beloved pet, precious Abby.

In addition to his wife he was predeceased by two brothers, Calvin and Lynwood Vaughan.
