Blanche Foster Page, 92, died peacefully at her home on Wednesday, March 3, 2021, surrounded by her children.

Born June 21, 1928, she was the daughter of the Tom Franklin & Josie Slaughter Foster. She was a graduate of Bartlett Yancey High School, & the University of North Carolina at Greensboro. She taught Business Education for seven years in Ellerbe, NC, & 31 years at Bartlett Yancey. She was head of the Business Department & treasurer for the school at BY for many years. She was a member & past president of the Alpha Delta Chapter of Delta Kappa Gamma (an honorary organization for women teachers), the Purley-Blanch Home Demonstration Club, & the Caswell Chapter 239, Order of the Eastern Star. She was a lifetime & faithful member of First Baptist Church of Yanceyville, where she served many years as a Sunday School teacher.

She was predeceased by the love of her life, Bedford J. "Buck" Page; her parents, & sisters Glenna Steagall & Joann Foster.

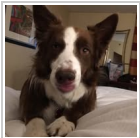
