



Bobby Hunt

September 23, 1937 - June 23, 2012

Bobby G. Hunt, 74, of Milton, NC died at his residence on June 23, 2012.

Mr. Hunt was born in Danville, VA on September 28, 1937 the second son of the late Holmes Penn Hunt Sr. and Mable Johnson Hunt. After his graduation from Bartlett Yancey High School, Class of 1955 he served with the U.S. Air Force. After his military service Mr. Hunt began an extraordinary career in agriculture and the tobacco industry that spanned forty-eight years until his retirement from Dimon Tobacco Company.

On May 3, 1964 he married Lorena Anne Merritt Hunt of Wheeling, West Virginia who predeceased him on October 10, 1988.

Mr. Hunt is survived by his son, H. Glenn Hunt and wife Courtney Hunt and their son Connor G. Hunt. He is also survived by one sister Patsy H. Bass and husband Donald of Ringgold, VA, his sister-in-law Nancy H. Hunt of Milton and by a long time family friend Wang-Jin. He was predeceased by two brothers Holmes Penn Hunt Jr. and Thomas Walker Hunt.

Funeral Services will be conducted from the Graveside in Highland Burial Park on Tuesday, June 26, 2012 at 4:00 p.m. by the Reverend Dr. Phillip Hoffman with Presentation of the United States Flag by the U.S. Army Honor Guard to follow.
