



Bobby Hylton

May 7, 1935 - January 30, 2012

Bobby James Hylton, 76, of 100 Parkway Drive, Danville, VA, died Monday, January 30, 2012 at his residence after a battle with cancer since September of 2011.

Mr. Hylton was born on May 7, 1935 in Pittsylvania County, VA, a son of the late Charles Dickerson Hylton, Sr. and the late Elsie Owen Hylton.

He lived most of his life in Danville, VA and retired, after 49 years, from Westover Garage where he had worked as owner and operator. He was a member of Brosville United Methodist Church, and a life member of the V.F.W. Post 647.

He was a veteran, serving in the U.S. Army as an M.P. in the Korean War.

On July 1, 1960 he married Judith H. Hylton, who survives.

In addition to his wife, of the residence, he is survived by a son, Brad Hylton of Durham, NC; a daughter, Julie H. Buchanan, and husband Sandy, of Greensboro, NC; twin granddaughters, Annie and Bebe Buchanan; and three sisters, Kitty Strange, and husband Aubrey, Hilda Blair, and husband W.T., and Dove McCall.

He was predeceased by a son, Jason Howard Hylton; three brothers, Charles Hylton, Jr., Vernon Hylton and Gene Hylton; and a sister, Dorothy Woodall.

Mr. Hylton requested a private memorial service for immediate family to celebrate his life.
