Bobby Daves Taylor, 87, of Ringgold, went home to be with the Lord on Friday, April 12, 2024 at Carilion Roanoke Memorial Hospital.

Born in Danville on March 22, 1937, he was a son of the late William Allan Taylor and Esther Mae Murphy Taylor. He grew up in Ringgold, Virginia and graduated Dan River High School in 1956.

On May 11, 1957, he married Darsie “Doris” Jane Doss, and celebrated over 66 years together.

Bobby was employed by C&P Telephone Company, later Verizon, until his retirement. He was a member of Ringgold Baptist church where he served as a Deacon, Sunday School Director and Sunday School Teacher. He was also a member of the Dan River Ruritan Club.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by his two children, Pamela Taylor Turner, of Richmond, VA and Ronnie Taylor (Kathy), of Ringgold, VA and one grandson, Aaron Taylor (Catharine).

He was preceded in death by his parents and a brother, William Allan Taylor, Jr.

The family will receive friends on Tuesday, April 16, 2024 from 6:00 p.m. until 7:30 p.m. at the Wrenn-Yeatts North Main Chapel.

A graveside service will be held on Wednesday, April 17, 2024 at 2:00 p.m. at Highland Burial Park with Pastor Duane Caldwell officiating.
