



Bruce Aaron Goodman

Bruce Aaron Goodman, 72, of 486 Hundred Acre Rd., Ringgold, VA, died on Sunday, June 25, 2017 at his residence after being in declining health for the past several years.

Mr. Goodman was born in Danville, VA on November 20, 1944, a son of the late Luther H. Goodman Sr. and the late Lillie Buck Goodman. He spent his entire life in the Danville and Pittsylvania County where he worked for the former Belk-Leggetts prior to becoming Belk Inc. While working for Belk-Leggetts he was awarded the Pace Setter Award. Bruce was a great artist who loved painting and drawing out of cardboard and popsicle sticks. He was blessed with his artistic talents, but most of all he loved to study God's Word daily. He was a member of Saint Mark Pentecostal Holiness Church where he worked in the Vacation Bible School where he made all of the back drops.

On October 29, 1966, he married Barbara Murphy Goodman, who survives of the residence.

In addition to his wife, Bruce is survived by three daughters, Tammy Stanley and husband Rance, of Ringgold, VA, Sandy Adkins and husband Tim, also of Ringgold, and Hope Farthing and husband Dan, of Keeling, VA; six grandchildren, Christie Barker and husband Matthew, Cody Stanley, Lily Adkins, Savannah Adkins, Emily Farthing, and Danielle Farthing; one great

granddaughter, Olivia Barker; and two Godchildren, Scott Carter and Susan Hendrix.

In addition to his parents, Bruce was predeceased by a son, Bruce A. Goodman, Jr., one brother, and one sister.

Funeral services will be conducted on Wednesday, June 28, 2017 at 2:00 p.m. at Saint Mark Pentecostal Holiness Church with the Rev. Dr. Jerry Foley and the Rev. Roger Collins officiating. Interment will follow the service in the Goodman Family Cemetery, 486 Hundred Acre Rd., Ringgold, VA.
