Bruce Yeatts Wiles, Sr., 72, of Danville, VA, died on Monday, August 27, 2018, at his residence, after a decline in health for the past year.

Mr. Wiles was born in Danville, VA on May 10, 1946 a son of the late Armistead Yeatts Wiles and the late Odell Owen Wiles. 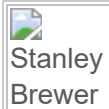

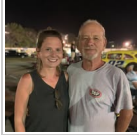
