



## Calvin Maurice Barbour

April 15, 1924 - May 1, 2015

Calvin Maurice Barbour, 91, formally of 156 Parkway Drive, Danville, died on Friday May 1, 2015 at Abington Place after being in declining health for three years.

Mr. Barbour was born in Pittsylvania County on April 15, 1924, son of the late Percy Hunter Barbour and the late Bessie Watlington Barbour. He spent all of his life in the Pittsylvania County area where he worked as a letter carrier for the US Post Office. Prior to working at the post office, he worked for the Danville City Water Department for 17 years. He proudly served his country in the US Navy, and was a lifetime member of the VFW.

Mr. Barbour was a family man who enjoyed sports and was an avid Giants fan. He was a member of Vandola Baptist Church.

On April 13, 1968 he married Vilma Harvey Barbour, who survives.
