Calvin Gilbert Setliff, 83, of 116 Rugby Rd Danville, died Saturday, August 11, 2012 at Danville Regional Medical Center after a decline in health for the past year. Mr. Setliff was born in Rockingham County, NC on February 11, 1929, the son of the late Willie Joe and Mary Hutson Setliff. He worked as a Truck Driver where he was employed by J. Clint Fleming, Old Dominion, Spartan Trucking, Pilot, Associated Transport, and retired from Estes Express Lines. He served in the U. S. Army from 1950-1956. He was a lifetime, and founding member of Ferry Roads Friends Church where he had served as Trustee. On February 26, 1949 he married Ora Mae Daniels Setliff, who died on February 5, 2003. He is survived by a son, Gregory D. Setliff, of the residence, and a Granddaughter, Allison M. Setliff, of Danville.
