



Carl West Stanley Jr.

January 10, 1963 - February 17, 2023

On Friday, February 17, 2023, Carl West Stanley, Jr., 60, of Yanceyville, NC, passed away peacefully while surrounded by his family at his residence.

Carl was born in Alamance County, NC in January, 1963, to Patricia Webster Stanley and the late Carl West Stanley. He lived his entire life in Yanceyville, NC and had retired several years earlier from the Hyco Lake Power Plant where he worked as a welder.

To know Carl was to know that he loved his family fiercely and he was incredibly proud of his three boys. He married Veronica Clay Stanley on February 26, 2000, and they raised a beautiful family together. 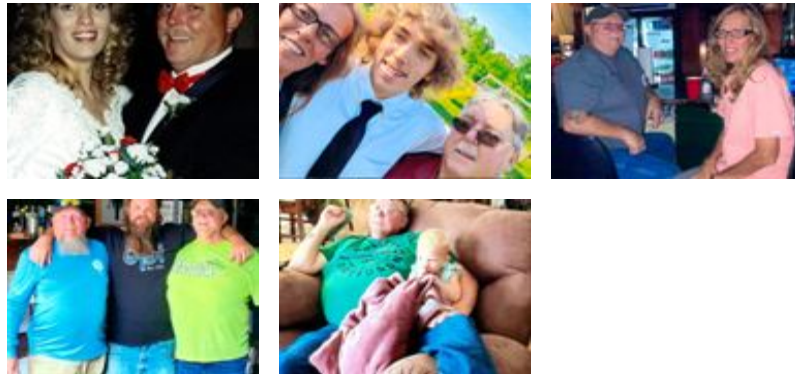
