Carol Edison Robertson, 85, of 1582 Halifax Road, Danville, VA died on Tuesday, March 11, 2014 at Piney Forest Healthcare after being in declining health for several years.

Mr. Robertson was born on January 17, 1929 a son of the late Clarence Edison Robertson and the late Dessie Pratt Robertson. He grew up in the Callands community and then moved to the Danville area where he lived for over fifty years. He worked for The Goodyear Tire and Rubber Co. until his retirement.
