Carolyn Chandler Lunsford, 85, of 135 Old Montgomery Road, Milton, NC went home to be with the Lord on February 22, 2022 in Person Memorial Hospital in Roxboro, NC after a recent decline in health.

Mrs. Lunsford was born Caswell County, NC on June 11, 1936 a daughter to the late John Chandler and Dorothy Yarbrough Chandler. She had lived her entire life in the Estelle Community of Caswell County.
