Carroll Winford Elliott, 73, of 325 Turpin Street, Danville, VA died on Monday, June 1, 2015 in the Hospice of Rockingham County after being in declining health for the past eighteen months.

Carroll was born in Danville, VA on June 28, 1941 a son of the late Luther Herman Elliott and Belva Wells Elliott.
