Cecil Leon Carter, 85, of 184 Laramie Circle, Danville, VA died on Saturday, March 18, 2017 at Danville Regional Medical Center.

Mr. Carter was born in Keeling, VA on May 8, 1931 son of the late Hugh William Carter and the late Irvin Gertrude Walton Carter. He lived most of his life in the Danville area where he was a meat cutter for Piggly Wiggly for 24 years until his retirement. He was a member of Kentuck Baptist Church. He was also a member of the Redmen Poquoson Tribe #124, the degree of Pocahontas Wyanette Council 22 and the Loyal Order of the Moose.

On February 14, 1959, he married Ethel Ward Carter who died on April 11, 2008.
