



## Cecile Henderson Shelton

May 26, 1927 - September 12, 2014

Cecile Henderson Shelton died peacefully on September 12, 2014, at Roman Eagle Rehabilitation & Health Care Center, Inc. in Danville, VA. Born on May 26, 1927, in Halifax County, she was the daughter of the late Roy Satterfield and Eva Mae Henderson. She spent her entire life in south central Virginia except for the time that she attended college. She was married to Gallie Thomas Shelton, Jr. for 68 years who preceded her in death. She also was preceded in death by her son, Roy Thomas Shelton.

She attended Flora McDonald College (now St. Andrews Presbyterian University). She held several secretarial positions, including as secretary for Wilson Memorial Elementary School. She retired from Burlington Industries in Halifax, where she worked as a Personnel Assistant. After retirement, she and her husband relocated to Danville, VA where they have lived for 23 years. She was a life-time member of Oak Level Presbyterian Church where she taught Sunday school and was an active member of the Women of the Church.

She is survived by her daughters Gloria Gibson (Charlotte, NC) and Linda Dunn (Danville). She is also survived by her son-in-law William E. (Scooter) Dunn and her grandchildren, Brooke Harrelson (Charlotte) and Hunter Dunn (Danville).
