



Celmer Maddox Morgan

January 26, 1930 - July 26, 2014

Celmer Ilene Maddox Morgan, 84, of 7917 Epsons Road, Gladys VA, died Saturday, July 26, 2014 at her residence after being in declining health for one year.

Mrs. Morgan was born on January 26, 1930 in Amherst, VA, a daughter of the late John Sam Maddox and Emma Gibson Maddox. She lived most of her life in Danville, VA, and retired in 1980, due to disability, from Dan River Mills, Inc.

She was a member of Melville Avenue Baptist Church, Danville, VA, Ebenezer Baptist Church, Naruna, VA, and the Ladies Auxiliary of the V.F.W. Post 647.

On April 6, 1968 she married Herman Lee Morgan who died on July 1, 2000.

In addition to her husband and parents, she was predeceased by her In-laws, Allen Morgan and Bertha Morgan; a brother, Clayton Maddox; a sister, Barbara Horn, and a step-son, J.P. Morgan.
