Charles Waddill Anderson Jr (Chuck), passed away unexpectedly at his home on Tuesday, October 1, 2024. Charles was born January 21, 1964 in Danville, VA where he lived most of his life.

His education was at Sutherlin Academy, Danville Christian School with graduation in 1982 at Dan River High. He was a member of Ringgold Baptist Church in Ringgold, Va.

Charles was a barber, a gourmet sous chef, a gardener, and an excellent photographer known on social media as “unrealizedpotential_usp” (Charles Anderson Photography). He enjoyed playing football as well as impersonating Elvis and was a friend to all who knew him. In the past few years he was employed at a local convenience store.

He is survived by his mother, Jackie Clark Anderson-who he dearly loved and provided for; his sister Elizabeth Anderson Stump, her husband Robert D. Stump, his nephew Zully Pukanecz of Ohio, and many cousins. He was the son of the late Charles W. Anderson.

A celebration of his life will be held Saturday, October 5 at 2:00 P.M.at Ringgold Baptist Church in Ringgold, VA. The family will receive friends prior to the service from 1:00 P.M. to 2:00 P.M.

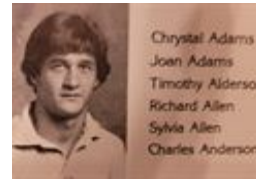
