



## Charles Reynolds

August 27, 1932 - March 20, 2010

Mr. Charles Wesley Reynolds, age 77, formerly of the Abingdon Place, died Saturday evening, March 20, 2010 Riverside Health Care & Rehab Center after a decline in health for five years.
