



Charlie W. Baynes

Mr. Charlie W. Baynes, age 92 of 136 North Woodberry Avenue, Danville, died Tuesday, February 25, 2014 at Danville Regional Medical Center after a short illness.

Mr. Baynes was born on October 27, 1921 in Halifax County, Va., a son of the late Charlie Nathan Baynes and the late Elizabeth Smith Baynes. He had lived most of his life in Danville where he was employed by the ABC Board for many years until his retirement. He was a member of Christ Episcopal Church for thirty three years. He served in the U.S. Army during World War II. He was a member of Improved Order of Redmen, Poquoson Tribe #124 and Degree of Pocahontas. On March 18, 1944, he was married to Lucille Boaze Baynes, who survives.

In addition to his wife of the residence, he is survived by two sons, Donald W. Baynes and wife, Dot, Randall N.
