Charlie Thomas Belcher, Jr., 61, of 2720 Kerns Church Road, Sutherlin, VA died on Sunday, August 12, 2012 at his residence after being in declining health for the past four years. Mr. Belcher was born in Danville, VA, on August 28, 1950 a son of the late Charlie T. Belcher, Sr. and the late Helen Ingram Belcher.
