Charlie Albert Smith, 84, of 267 South 7th Street, Yanceyville, NC died at Sovah-Danville on Wednesday, September 28, 2022 after being in declining health for the past two years. Charlie was born in Pittsylvania County on May 31, 1938, a son of the late Albert Smith and Carrie Bell Paschal. He was of the Baptist faith.
