Mrs. Charlotte W. Powell, 93, passed away peacefully on Sunday, May 29, 2016.

Funeral services to celebrate her life will be held at Vandola Baptist Church on Thursday, June 2 at 4:00 PM with Dr. Scott Bortz officiating. Burial will follow Danville Memorial Gardens. The receiving of family and friends will be held at Vandola Baptist Church prior to the funeral services beginning at 2:30 PM.

Mrs. Powell was born in Pittsylvania County, Virginia on October 11, 1922 to P.O. Wall and Marjorie Moss Wall, who predeceased her.
