January 30, 1919 - October 20, 2011

Chloe Frances Bailey Slayton, age 92, died at Roman Eagle Memorial Home on Thursday, October 20, 2011. Born January 30, 1919, in Gretna, Virginia, she was the daughter of Mamie Hines Bailey and Walter Shepard Bailey. Mrs. Slayton grew up on a farm in the Greenfield Community near Gretna and graduated from Gretna High School in 1937. In 1940, she was the recipient of the Julian Kaufman award when she graduated from The Memorial Hospital School of Nursing. On October 15, 1945, she married Henry I. Slayton, Jr. Mrs. Slayton was a member of First Baptist Church and was an accomplished cook, gardener, and needle artist, most particularly traditional rug hooking. In addition to her husband, she is survived by one daughter, Jane Willis, and husband, Steve; one granddaughter, Elizabeth; and one sister, Ida B. Bailey. A celebration of her life will be held at First Baptist Church at 11:00 am on Saturday, October 22, 2011 conducted by Dr. Frank Campbell. Interment will follow in Highland Burial Park. The family will receive friends at First Baptist Church on Friday evening from 7:00 to 8:30. At other times they will be at her daughter's residence, 111 Wilton Avenue.
