



Cindy Bradley Soyars

May 3, 1960 - November 1, 2021

Cindy Marie Bradley Soyars, 61, of 1540 Olde Hunting Trail, Danville, VA, died on November 1, 2021 at Sovah Health in Danville after being in declining health for the past three years.

Cindy was born on May 3, 1960 in New Port News, VA, a daughter of the late James Richard Bradley and Gaynelle Hanks Perkins. She spent most of her life in the Danville area where she first worked for Brockway until she received her nursing degree. She then went on to work as a LPN for Roman Eagle Nursing Home until her retirement due to disability. 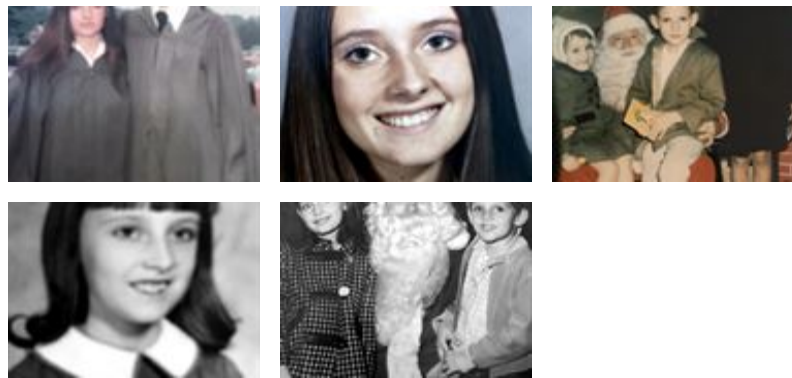
